### **A. Method of Screening**

### **UTME Candidates**

All candidates must have taken the 2020/2021 UTME Examination and obtained a minimum score of **160**. The minimum qualification for Degree programmes is five (5) relevant O/Level Credits including Mathematics and English at not more than two (2) sittings.

### **Direct Entry**

Direct Entry admission candidates must have completed JAMB Direct Entry form, obtained five (5) relevant O/Level Credits including Mathematics and English at not more than two (2) sittings and an A/Level result (IJMB, National Diploma with a minimum of Lower Credit and Cambridge A/Levels result).
